



Here is an update on the church building opening up the doors this coming June. All of these plans are contingent on current regulations holding true for the coming weeks.

When we open the doors, we will be sure to let everyone know the date that will happen. We will be implementing new protocols.

Protocols:

Only 50 people will be allowed in the building to start as per the mandate. We will have some pews closed off and some others open so to maintain the 6 foot distance. We strongly encourage everyone who attends to wear a facemask. We will also have hand sanitizer available for use. The café will remain closed. We will also be working on a new way to serve communion so that everyone can remain and feel safe during this time. We will continue the livestreaming services until all restrictions are lifted and most people feel comfortable to return to morning worship.

We will not be having any other weekly meetings, such as Tuesday morning Bible study or men's and women's breakfasts until at least the fall, but youth group will start up again if parents are okay with it. The reason being is so that we will have adequate time to sanitize the building during the week in preparation for the next Sunday.

We will be sure to keep you up to date on any changes.
